



SIZE GUIDE

Selecting the right bracelet size is more important than you may think. The correct fit makes sure your bracelet will be comfortable to wear and will be as chic on your arm as you expect it to be.

HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT BRACELET SIZE

Use the guide below to measure your wrist accurately and find the bracelet size that suits you best.

1. To measure your wrist circumference, all you need is a flexible measuring tape or a cord with a ruler. You can also use our special printable sizer. Make sure you print it at 100% scale on A4 paper.
2. Wrap your wrist's narrowest point with the measuring tape or the printed size chart tightly but still comfortably. Make sure it fits snugly.
3. Now mark the crossing ends of it with a pencil. This is your wrist circumference.
4. This will be the cm you have to correspond to your bracelet size.

If You're Between Sizes

If your measurement falls between two sizes, choosing the larger option is usually the safer choice. This is especially helpful when buying a bracelet as a gift or when you're unsure about the preferred fit.

If your wrist is 16,5 cm, choose the 17 cm size. The clasp adds about 1-1.5 cm, for example, a bracelet ordered 17 cm large, is delivered about 18 - 18.5 cm (including clasp), but it will fit the originally ordered size 17.

Amarcord Collection City: these Simple Charm or Link bracelets typically follow the shape of the wrist and the size will be closer to your actual wrist measurement. Also remember that you have an extension chain of 2 cm to add length your bracelet size.

S	5.9 - 6.7	15 - 17
M	6.7 - 7.5	17 - 19
L	7.5 - 8.3	19 - 21

All Amarcord Marine bracelets are handmade, for this reason they can be 2-3 mm different in size.
